Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership and control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies. Certain John D. Dovich & Associates personnel also serve as registered representatives of a registered broker/dealer and information may be shared with that broker/dealer to assist that broker/dealer in meeting its regulatory oversight obligations.		
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or service to you. • We do not jointly market.
